Flyerz is open to disabled and non-disabled people, inclusive to any disability, long-term health condition and/or additional need.

WHY:

Disabled people are twice as likely to be inactive as non-disabled people in the UK with 7 out of 10 wanting to be more active. Access Sport passionately believe that everyone should have access to the health, wellbeing and developmental benefits of sport. By joining the Flyerz movement, hockey clubs can successfully engage disabled people with non-disabled people on equal terms, connect communities, and improve wellbeing.
